

CHAPTER 212.

[H. F. No. 959.]

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF GIVING RELIEF TO PERSONS WHO LOST THEIR CROPS BY HAIL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Relief of sufferers from hail.

SECTION 1. That the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of giving aid to those persons who lost their crops by hail during the summer of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six (1886), in the counties of Marshall, Polk, Swift, Norman, Chippewa, Lac qui Parle, Big Stone or any other counties in the state of Minnesota.

SEC. 2. Said sum shall be expended under the direction of the governor of the state of Minnesota.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 213.

[H. F. No. 116.]

AN ACT TO FIX THE SALARY OF THE ADJUTANT GENERAL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Salary of adjutant general.

SECTION 1. The salary of the Adjutant General for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887) and annually thereafter shall be two thousand (2000) dollars per annum.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts in conflict with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
