steward shall also forward one (1) set of bills and vouchers for the preceding month, which shall be filed by the state auditor in his office and kept for public inspection.

CHAPTER 250.

(S. F. No. 124.)

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REIMBURSE THE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF SAUK RAPIDS IN BENTON COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Reimburses independent school district of Sank Rapids, Section 1. That the sum of five thousand (5,000) dollars is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the general revenue fund or out of the first money that shall come into the treasury belonging to said fund, not already appropriated, for the purpose of partially re-imbursing the independent school district of Sauk Rapids in Benton county, for moneys paid and liabilities incurred for rebuilding a school house destroyed by a cyclone, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six (1886).

SEC. 2. The state auditor is hereby empowered and directed to draw his order in favor of the treasurer of said school district on the state treasurer for the said sum of five thousand (5,000) dollars belonging to said fund; Provided, That no part of said money shall be used or expended for any other purpose than paying liabilities incurred in rebuilding said school house or in paying and satisfying obligations which said district may have incurred for the purpose of raising money to rebuild said school house.

When act to take effect.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
