

CHAPTER 234.

[H. F. No. 989.]

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DES MOINES IN THE COUNTY OF JACKSON TO HOLD TOWN MEETINGS AND GENERAL ELECTIONS IN THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the people of the township of Des Moines, in the county of Jackson, be and the same are hereby authorized to hold their town meetings and general elections within the incorporate limits of the village of Jackson in the said county of Jackson; and the supervisors of said Des Moines township are hereby authorized to meet and transact business within the incorporate limits of said village of Jackson the same as provided by statute for meeting in the township.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 235.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF WATSON TO EXPEND MONEY FROM THE VILLAGE TREASURY TO BUILD A BRIDGE ACROSS THE MINNESOTA RIVER IN CHIPPEWA COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. The village council of the village of Watson, in Chippewa county, are hereby authorized to expend any moneys in the treasury of said village not to exceed eight hundred (800) dollars, to aid in building a bridge across the Minnesota river on or near the section line between sections twenty-nine (29) and thirty-two (32) in town one hundred and eighteen (118) in range forty-one (41) Chippewa county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
