

CHAPTER 236.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE PROBATE COURT OF HENNEPIN COUNTY TO GRANT LICENSE TO THE ADMINISTRATOR WITH THE WILL ANNEXED OF THE ESTATE OF LEVI BUTLER, DECEASED, TO SELL THE REAL ESTATE BELONGING TO SAID ESTATE AND TO FINISH THE SETTLEMENT OF SAID ESTATE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The probate court of the county of Hennepin is hereby authorized and empowered to grant to the administrator with the will annexed of the estate of Levi Butler, late of Hennepin county, deceased, license to sell any real estate in the state belonging to said estate, upon such administrator with the will annexed applying therefor, as provided by chapter 57 of the general statutes. Such license may authorize such sale or sales to be at private sale or public auction as provided in said chapter, and such sale or sales shall be reported to the probate court by such administrator with the will annexed and the same confirmed by such probate court as provided by said chapter.

SEC. 2. The administrator with the will annexed of the estate of said deceased is hereby authorized and empowered to make and file in the probate court of said county his final account with said estate and finally settle said estate, and said probate court is fully authorized and empowered to settle said account and to make all necessary and proper orders and decrees in and about the sale of said real estate and the settlement of said estate, to the same extent and with the same force and effect as it might have done had said account been settled and said estate fully settled within the time heretofore allowed for the settlement of estates of deceased persons.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
