CHAPTER 260.

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBERED SIXTY-FOUR (64), OF RENVILLE COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the south one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of sections twenty-five (25), twenty-six (26) and twenty-seven (27), all of sections thirty-four (34) and thirty-five (35), and the west one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of section (36), all in township numbered one hundred and fifteen (115), north of range numbered thirty-four (34) west, in the county of Renville, and state of Minnesota, be and the same is hereby detached from independent school district numbered sixty-four (64) of Renville county aforesaid.

SEC. 2. All taxes levied on said detached territory for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six (1886), and prior years, shall be paid to and collected by said independent school district num-

bered sixty-four (64).

SEC. 3. The scholars residing in said detached territory shall be allowed to attend the public schools in said independent school district numbered sixty-four (64) during the balance of the present school year.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 261.

[S. F. No. 565.]

AN ACT TO DEFINE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT OF DULUTH.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

Section 1. The boundaries of the independent school district of Duluth in St. Louis county shall be co-extensive and identical with the boundaries of the city of Duluth.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are

hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
