

CHAPTER 272.

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE LIMITS OF THE NORTHFIELD VILLAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section thirty-five (35) in township No. one hundred and twelve (112) north, of range No. twenty (20) west, in Rice county, Minnesota, be and the same is hereby joined to and made a part of the Northfield village school district in said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 273.

AN ACT TO CREATE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER THREE (3) IN THE COUNTIES OF MORRISON AND BENTON.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory in the counties of Morrison and Benton be and the same is hereby created an Independent school district, to be known as "Independent school district number three (3), of the counties of Morrison and Benton," to-wit:

Sections ten (10), eleven (11), twelve (12), thirteen (13), fourteen (14), twenty-three (23), twenty-four (24), twenty-five (25), twenty-six (26), thirty-one (31), thirty-two (32), thirty-three (33), thirty-four (34), thirty-five (35), thirty-six (36), in township thirty-nine (39), range thirty-two (32); and section thirty (30), thirty-one (31) and thirty-two (32) in township thirty-nine (39), range thirty-one (31), all in Morrison county; and sections one (1), two (2), three (3), four (4), five (5), nine (9), ten (10), eleven (11), twelve (12), and all that part of sections fourteen (14) and fifteen (15) lying west of Platte river, all in said Benton county; with all the powers, duties and privileges an immunities of other independent school districts in this state, except that the board of education of said district shall not be a body corporate.
