south of the Winona & St. Peter railroad track, all in section thirty-four (34), town one hundred and eight (108), range twenty-four (24), and the south half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the northeast quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$, and the northeast quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of section three (3), town one hundred and seven (107), range twenty-four (24), now in the village of Janesville, in said county of Waseca, Minnesota, be and the same is hereby detached from said village of Janesville, and annexed to and made a part of school district number sixty-two (62) in said county of Waseca, Minnesota.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 279.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE BOUNDARIES OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN LE SUEUR COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the southwest quarter (SW1) of section nine (9) township one hundrod and eleven (111) north, of range number twenty-three (23) west, be detached and set off from school district number sixty (60) in the county of Le Sueur, and annexed to and made a part of school district number ninety-two (92), in the same county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
