CHAPTER 290.

(H. F. No. 769.)

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE INCORPORATION OF NORTH STAR LODGE NO. SIX (6), INDEPENDENT ORDER OF, ODD FELLOWS OF MINNE-APOLIS, AND TO CURE ANY DEFECTS IN THE PROCEEDINGS TO INCORPORATE SAID LODGE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The incorporation of North Star Lodge, No. six (6), Independent Order of Odd Fellows, located at Minneapolis, Minnesota, is hereby legalized and made valid notwithstanding any omission to attach a seal to the articles of incorporation thereof, or other defects or omissions in the attempt to incorporate the same, and such defects and omissions are hereby cured, and said incorporation made valid from and of the date of its articles of incorporation.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 291.

(H, F, No. 839)

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE AND CONFIRM THE BOUNDARIES OF CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN SIBLEY COUNTY THEREIN NAMED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the establishment of school district number forty-five (45) in the county of Sibley, be and the same is hereby confirmed and made valid and said school district thus established shall be comprised of all the following described territory, to-wit:

All of sections [number] four (4), five (5), six (6), seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), sixteen (16), except lots four (4) and five (5), seventeen (17) and eighteen (18), all in township number one hundred and fourteen (114), range number twenty-seven (27); also the south-east quarter (SE4), and the south one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the southwest quarter (S4 S W 4) of section number one (1), also the northeast quarter (NE4) and the north one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the southeast quarter (NE4) of section number (12), town one hundred and fourteen (114), range, number twenty-eight (28).

SEC. 2. That the establishment of school district number sixty-six (66), in the county of Sibley, be and the same is hereby confirmed and

made valid and said school district thus established shall be comprised of all the following described territory, to-wit:

The west one-half of the west one-half of the northwest quarter $(W_{2}^{1}W_{2}^{1}NW_{4}^{1})$ of section six (6), town one hundred and thirteen (113), range twenty-seven (27); southwest quarter (SW_{4}^{1}) of section thirty-one (31), town one hundred and fourteen (114), range twenty-seven (27), all of section one (1); northeast quarter (NE₄) and south one-half of northwest quarter $(S_{2}^{1}NW_{4}^{1})$, and northeast quarter of northwest quarter $(NE_{4}^{1}NW_{4}^{1})$ of section number two (2), town one hundred and thirteen (113), range twenty-eight (28); section thirty-six (36, except north one-half of the northwest quarter $(N_{2}^{1}N-W_{4}^{1})$, south one-half of southeast quarter $(S_{2}^{1}SE_{4}^{1})$, and northeast quarter of southeast quarter (NE_{4}^{1}SE_{4}^{1}) of section number thirty-five (35), town one hundred and fourteen (114), range twenty-eight (28).

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHÁPTER 292.

[H. F. No. 765.]

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE CERTAIN RECORDS IN BIG STONE COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the record and filing of all deeds or other instruments required or authorized by law to be recorded or filed in the office of the register of deeds, which were made or filed in the office of the register, or acting register of deeds of the said county of Big Stone, prior to the organization of said county, by act of the legislature approved February eight (8), one thousand eight hundred and eightyseven (1887, are hereby declared to be legal from the time of such record or filing. And all records, filings, books, papers or other things pertaining to the office of register of deeds of said county, prior to the time of such organization, shall, upon reasonable demand, be turned over and surrendered to the present register of deeds, who is hereby required to make demand therefor, and to receive, receipt for and to keep and preserve the same for inspection in his office as part and parcel of the records and filings thereof, providing that the provisions of this act shall not apply to any action or proceeding now pending in any court of this state.

SEC 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
