CHAPTER 299.

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER EIGHTY-TWO (82) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF MINNESOTA FOR THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter eighty-two (82) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), the same being entitled an act to amend chapter nineteen (19) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), entitled an "act to incorporate the village of Pine Island in the county of Goodhue, state of Minnesota," be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTE

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO (262) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885). AN ACT REGULATING THE CATCHING OF FISH IN THE MINNESOTA RIVER IN THE COUNTIES OF CHIP-PEWA AND YELLOW MEDICINE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter two hundred and sixty-two (262) of the special laws one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
