

**CHAPTER 359.**

AN ACT FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE JUDGE OF PROBATE  
OF HENNEPIN COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The salary of the judge of probate of Hennepin county shall be the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) per annum, to be paid as now provided by law.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

**CHAPTER 360.**

[H. F. No. 967.]

AN ACT ATTACHING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE ROAD DISTRICT  
CONSISTING OF THE VILLAGE OF APPLETON.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. The following described territory, to-wit: Sections numbered twenty-two (22), twenty-three (23), twenty-seven (27), twenty-eight (28), thirty-three (33) and thirty-four (34), of the township of Appleton and the county of Swift, are hereby attached to and made a part of the road district, consisting of the village of Appleton in said county for road purposes only, and all of said territory is hereby detached from the districts in which the same is now situated.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
