

SEC. 2. This act shall not affect any existing establishment or any person now engaged in the business described in this act within the territory defined in section one (1) of this act, until the city of Saint Paul shall have paid, or caused to be paid, to the persons owning such establishments, and carrying on such business, the damages suffered by such persons by the operation of this act, such damages to be ascertained and paid in the manner now prescribed by law for the ascertainment and payment of damages in the case of the condemnation of land for highway purposes, and the payment of damages therefor in the city of Saint Paul, nor until sixty (60) days after the payment of such damages.

SEC. 3. The city of Saint Paul is hereby authorized and empowered to pay the damages provided for in this act.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 371.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF FROG LAKE, IN STEVENS COUNTY, TO LAKE GORDER.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of that certain lake in the county of Stevens, this state, known as Frog lake, be and the same is hereby changed to Lake Gorder.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 372.

AN ACT TO SEPARATE THE TOWN OF LEROY FROM THE VILLAGE OF LEROY, MOWER COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the territory known and designated as the township of Leroy, being township number one hundred and one (101) north, of range numbered fourteen (14) west P. M. in the
