## CHAPTER 62.

[H. F. No. 913.]

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE [1] OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, APPROVED MARCH SIX [6], ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY.-THREE [1883], ENTITLED, "AN ACT TO AMEND AND CONSOLIDATE THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF FERGUS FALLS."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section five (5) of chapter four (4) of chapter one (1) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three (1883), be amended by inserting after the word intemperance in the fourth (4th) line of said section, the words, "for the purpose of revenue."

SEC. 2. That sub-division fifth (5th) of said section five (5) shall be amended by inserting after the word "license" in the third (3rd) line of said subdivision, the words, "for the purpose of revenue."

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 63.

[H. F. 477.]

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER FORTY-SIX (46) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), INCORPORATING THE VILLAGE OF WADENA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That an act entitled "an act to incorporate the village of Wadena, in the county of Wadena," approved February fourteenth (14th), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one \$\\_1881\$), as the same has been since amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding at the end of section three (3) of said chapter, as the same was amended by chapter thirty-four (34) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), the following:

And provided further, That the village council of said village may audit, allow and cause to be paid, all reasonable and proper charges incurred by or in behalf of said village, without limitation as to the

amount of such charges.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
