

## CHAPTER 86.

[S. F. No. 117.]

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FREE WAGON BRIDGE ACROSS THE MINNESOTA RIVER BETWEEN THE TOWN OF SPARTA IN CHIPPEWA COUNTY AND THE TOWN OF STONY RUN IN YELLOW MEDICINE COUNTY, APPROVED MARCH TENTH, (10th) EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-NINE, (1879.)

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. Section six (6) of chapter one hundred and fifty-six (156) special laws of the state of Minnesota for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-nine (1879) is hereby amended so as to read as follows;

Section 6. Said bridge shall be maintained and kept in repair by the counties of Chippewa and Yellow Medicine, one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of such expense to be borne by each of said counties respectively and shall be forever free from toll.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 87.

(S. F. No. 304.)

AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (277) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885), RELATING TO THE CATCHING OF FISH IN "FOUR LAKES" WASHINGTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

*Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter two hundred and seventy-seven (277) of the special laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), be and the same is hereby amended as follows: The word "April" in the last line of said section shall be changed to the word "May."

SEC. 2. That section two (2) of said act shall be amended by adding the words, "or by the use of set lines of any description," at the end of said section two (2).

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
