

CHAPTER 115.

[S. F. No. 1.]

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER SEVENTY-FOUR (74) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE (1883,) ENTITLED THE MILITARY CODE, AND THE SEVERAL ACTS AMENDATORY THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

Provides for
three
regiments.

SECTION 1. That section one (1), of article one (1), of chapter seventy-four (74), of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-three (1883), entitled the Military code, be amended by striking out the words "two regiments" and inserting the words "three regiments."

Appropriates
\$10,000.

SEC. 2. That an additional sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) be and is hereby appropriated out of the general fund for the current fiscal year, and annually thereafter, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of said military code of eighteen hundred and eighty-three (1883,) and the amendments thereto.

Provided, that the amount expended in any year for the third regiment shall not exceed the amount herein appropriated.

When act to
take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 116.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1) OF CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND EIGHTEEN (218) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885), RELATING TO THE STATE LIBRARY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

State Library.

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter two hundred and eighteen (218) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following, to wit:
