

CHAPTER 152.

AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER EIGHTY-FOUR (84), OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE EXTRA SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND TWO (102), OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (1887) AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND ELECTION OF TWO (2) ADDITIONAL JUDGES IN THE FOURTH (4TH) JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter eighty-four (84), of the general laws of the extra session of the legislature of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), as amended by chapter one hundred and two (102) of the general laws of the session of the legislature of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the word and figure "four (4)" where the same occur in the second (2nd) line of section one (1) of said chapter eighty-four (84) as amended by said chapter one hundred and two (102) and by inserting in place thereof the word and figure "six" (6).

SEC. 2. That immediately upon the passage of this act the governor of this State shall appoint two (2) competent persons to be judges of the district court for the fourth (4th) judicial district of this State each of whom shall immediately thereafter qualify and enter upon the duties of said office, and shall hold said office until their successors respectively shall have been elected and qualified, which said successors shall be elected at the first (1st) general election which shall occur more than thirty (30) days after the passage of this act.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
