

CHAPTER 163.

[H. F. No. 1007.]

AN ACT LEGALIZING THE ACTS OF COUNTY AUDITORS WHO HAVE CERTIFIED TO THE VALIDITY OF SCHOOL DISTRICT BONDS AND ORDERS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Legalizing acts of county auditors in certain cases.

SECTION 1. Wherever the county auditor of any county has heretofore certified upon any school district bond, or order issued by any school district within his county, that such bond or order is issued in accordance with law and is a legal and valid debt of the school district issuing such bond or order, such certificate shall have the same force and effect as it would have, had such act been expressly authorized at the time such certificate was made.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 164.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWENTY-SEVEN (27) OF CHAPTER THIRTY-SIX (36) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT, BEING AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A SYSTEM OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

School district bonds and orders, how issued.

SECTION 1. That section twenty-seven (27) of chapter thirty-six (36) of the general statutes of the state of Minnesota of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), as the same has been amended and now reads, is hereby amended by adding to the end thereof the following, to-wit: Immediately after the issuing of orders or bonds pursuant to the provisions of this and the next preceding section, the clerk of the school district so issuing its orders or bonds shall file with the county auditor of the county within which such district is situated, certified copies of all the proceedings had in such district relative to the issue of such bonds or orders.
