

CHAPTER 201.

[H. F. No. 327.]

AN ACT REPEALING AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE PROCESS OF GARNISHMENTS, AS APPLIED TO WORKINGMEN.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter one hundred and seventy-nine (179) of the general laws of the state of Minnesota for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven (1887) be and the same is hereby repealed. Act repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER 202.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY-EIGHT (148) OF GENERAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (1887), RELATING TO SOLDIERS' HOME AND RELIEF.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section twenty-five (25) of chapter one hundred and forty-eight (148), general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven (1887), be amended and changed to read as follows:

"Section 25. The state auditor shall annually hereafter add to the tax levy of the state one-tenth (1-10) of one (1) mill on each dollar of the valuation of the state, both real and personal, to constitute a 'soldiers' relief fund,' and he shall, at the close of each fiscal year, transfer from the revenue fund to the soldiers' relief fund the amount of such levy not already credited to said relief fund." Tax levy for soldiers' relief fund.

SEC. 2. That section twenty-six (26) of the said chapter one hundred and forty-eight (148) of general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven (1887), be and the same is hereby amended by adding the following exception to the end of the first (1st) proviso of said section, as follows, viz.:

"Except that the trustees in their discretion may grant or provide transportation and rations en route for any honorably discharged ex-United States soldier, sailor or marine, or the dependent families of the same." Transportation.
