president of the Minnesota fish commission. The sum of two hundred (200) dollars annually is hereby appropriated to be paid for such purposes, out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE HUNDRED AND FOUR (104) OF CHAPTER SIX (6) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY. EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO COMMISSIONERS OF FISH-ERIES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. Section one hundred and four (104) of chap- Commissionter six (6), of the general statutes one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), is hereby amended by in-serting between the words "state" and "it" where they occur in the eleventh (11th) line of said section, the following words, to-wit: "And to institute and prosecute actions and proceedings on behalf of the state, against any person or persons to recover any claim or claims due said commissioners and arising on contract or otherwise, or to protect the property of the state employed in or in any manner connected with the work of said commissioners, and all actions or proceedings instituted by them shall be entitled: The commissioners of fisheries, against (naming the defendant).
