Section 32. "The superintendent of each Minnesota hospital for the insane is hereby required to give immediate notice to the next of kin of each patient under his charge, of the death, serious illness or any special change in the condition of such patient, and to answer promptly and fully all letters of inquiry received from the relatives of any patient in the hospital under his charge."

Superintendent to give immediate notice to next of kin in case of death, or serious illness.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 264.

[H. F. No. 571.]

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATION," APPROVED MARCH SEVENTH (7TH), EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter two hundred and nine (209), of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five (1885), be amended by omitting from the end of the section the following words, "and of which the professor of agriculture shall be general superintendent."

Professor of agriculture.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
