Anson Northrup for supplies furnished a company of mounted rangers raised by him for the defence of Fort Ridgely in the Sioux war of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two (1862), as per statement rendered to the committee on appropriations, and for which claim this sum shall be full satisfaction for such outlay.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from When act to take effect. and after its passage.

CHAPTER 285.

[S. F. No. 225]

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE CHARLES F. DINSMORE FOR LOSS SUSTAINED BY HIM FROM FIRE OF THE STATE PRISON, JANUARY TWENTY-FOUR (24), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FOUR (1884).

Be it enacted by the Legislatute of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The sum of ninety (90) dollars is hereby To reimburse appropriated out of any moneys of the state treasury not Dinsmore. otherwise appropriated, to reimburse Charles F. Dinsmore for loss sustained by him at the burning of the state prison at Stillwater, Minnesota, on the twenty-fourth (24th) day of January, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four (1884), said Dinsmore being then and there employed as a prison guard.

SEC. $\overline{2}$. The state auditor is hereby directed to draw his warrant, for the sum hereby appropriated, upon the state treasurer in favor of said Charles F. Dinsmore.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
