retary thereof, are hereby legalized and made valid, and shall have the same force and effect as if signed by the president and treasurer of such association.

## CHAPTER 74.

[8. F. No. 185.]

AN AOT TO AMEND SEGTION FOUR (4), OF OHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND SEVEN (107), OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND :EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEV. ENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO THE QUALTFIOATIONS OF GRAND JURORS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
Section 1. That section four (4), of chapter one hundred and seven (107), of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be and the sameis hereby amended so as to read as follows:
"Section 4 . The following persons are exempt from service as grand jarors: All United States officers, all judges of courts of record; commissioners of public buildings; auditor and treasurer of state; state librarian; clerks of court; registers of deeds; sheriffs and their deputies; coronere, constables, attorneys and counsellors at law; ministers of the gospel; preceptors and teachers of incorporated academies; one (1) teacher in earb common school; practicing physiciaus and surgeons; oi miller in each mill; one (1) ferryman to each licensed ferry; all acting telegraph operators; all postmasters and deputypostmasters; all members of companies of firemen organized according to law; all engineers having charge of stationary and locomotive engines; all persons of more than sixty ( 60 ) years of age; all persons of unsound mind; persons subject to bodily infirmity amounting to disability; all undertakers and their assistants; all persons are disqualified from serving as grand jarors who have been convicted of an(y) infamous crime."
