

CHAPTER 88.

[H. F. No. 533.]

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (181) OF CHAPTER EIGHT (8) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO REGISTERS OF DEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

Register of
deeds, deputies

SECTION 1. Section one hundred and eighty-one (181) of chapter eight (8) of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: "Sec. 181. He may appoint one (1) or more deputy registers in writing, who shall, before entering upon the duties of their offices, take and subscribe an oath faithfully to perform the duties of their offices, which oath shall be endorsed on the appointment and recorded in the office of the register of deeds. Registers of deeds shall be responsible for the acts of their deputies, and may revoke their appointment at pleasure."

When act to
take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 89.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO (2), CHAPTER SEVENTEEN (17), OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO BASTARDS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Amends laws
in relation to
bastards.

SECTION 1. That section two (2) of chapter seventeen (17) of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be amended by adding to the same the following words: The accused shall be entitled to a removal of such action as in criminal examination before justices of the peace.
