

CHAPTER 95.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SIX (286) OF CHAPTER SIXTY-SIX (66) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO SATISFACTIONS OF JUDGMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That section two hundred and eighty-six (286) of chapter sixty-six (66) of the general statutes of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) is hereby amended by adding thereto as follows: Any satisfaction made and acknowledged in the name of a partnership by a member of the partnership, shall be as valid and binding as if executed and acknowledged by each individual member of the partnership; *Provided*, That nothing herein shall be construed to apply to any case where such partnership has been dissolved prior to the making of such satisfaction.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 96.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1) CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FOUR (124) OF GENERAL STATUTES OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATIVE TO LEGAL HOLIDAYS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter one hundred and twenty-four (124) of general statutes of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "Section 1. That the twenty-second (22d) day of February, the anniversary of the birthday of Washington, and the thirtieth (30th) day of May, known as "memorial day," shall be observed in this state as legal holidays hereafter; that no public business, except in case of necessity, shall be transacted on
