A MEMORIAL BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE  
CONCURRING.

*Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

That our senators and representatives in congress be instructed and requested to present the following, and give it their support in Congress:

*To the Honorable the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States:*

The best interests of the State of Minnesota, and of a large number of its citizens require that congress consider, at an early day, the rights of the Northern Pacific railroad company and of the St. Paul, Minneapolis & Manitoba railway company, to large tracts of indemnity lands situate within said state, and adopt such measures of legislation, if any be practicable, as will conduce to a termination of the controversy now existing between the aforesaid companies respecting the titles of said lands.

*Resolved, further,* That the secretary of state be, and he is hereby requested to furnish one copy of this memorial to each of our senators and representatives in Congress, at as early a day as may be expedient.
