

## CHAPTER 174.

[S. F. No. 200.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. FIVE (5) OF WORTHINGTON, NOBLES COUNTY, TO ISSUE ITS BONDS RUNNING FIFTEEN (15) YEARS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. Independent school district No. five (5) of Worthington, Nobles county, Minnesota, is hereby authorized to issue its bonds to an amount not exceeding thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) as voted at a special meeting of said district, held August twentieth (20th), eighteen hundred and eighty-eight (1888). Said bonds to draw interest at a rate not exceeding six (6) per cent. per annum and to run for a period not exceeding fifteen (15) years.

SEC. 2. The proceeds of said bonds shall only be used for the purpose of building and furnishing a school house in said school district.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 175.

[H. F. No. 339.]

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SLAYTON, IN MURRAY COUNTY, IN THIS STATE, TO ISSUE BONDS TO THE AMOUNT OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000), FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPROVING THE STREETS OF SAID VILLAGE.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.*

SECTION 1. The village council of the village of Slayton in the county of Murray in this state is hereby authorized to issue the bonds of said village to an amount not exceeding the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) in such denominations as may by said council be deemed proper, payable in not more than ten (10) years, and to bear interest not greater than eight (8) per cent. per annum, payable annually, for the purpose of setting out shade and ornamental trees in the streets and for grading, repairing and otherwise improving the streets, lawns, alleys and other public grounds in said village of Slayton. *Provided*, That said bonds shall not be sold for less than par and shall be known as public ground improvement bonds of said village.
