Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
Seotion 1. That the village council of the village of Appleton in Swift county is hereby authorized and empowered to expend any money in the treasury of asid village, not otherwise appropriated, or any money or labor due or derived from poll or road tax, for the parpose of making any improvement on the public road extending from the corporate limits of said village, southward to the Minnesota river, said improvements to be made under the joint supervision of said village council and the board of supervisors of the townahip of Appleton.

Sec. 2. Chapter three hundred and sixty (360) of the special laws of eightien hundred and eighty-seven (1887) is hereby repealed.

SEc. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 279.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE VLLLAGE OF MORTON, RENVILLE OOUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, TO GRANT A REBATE OF THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY (350) DOLLARS TO THOSE PERSONS WHO TOOK OUT LIOENSES TO SELL INTOXICATING LIQUORS JANUARY TEN (10), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT (1888), IN SAID VILLAGE, COUNTY AND STATE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
Seotion 1. That the village council of the village of Morton, in the county of Renville, state of Minuesota, is hereby authorized and empowered to grant to all persons, a rebate of three hundred and fifty (350), dollars who took out licenses to sell intoxicating liquors January ten $(10)$,one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight, and whose license expired April two (2), one thousand eight handred and eighty-eight (1888), according to the provisions of chapter five (5) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), and to grant a rebate of three hundred and fifty (350) dollars, paid by them
