CHAPTER 297.

[H. F. No. 1080.]

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DODGE, STATE OF MINNESOTA, TO PAY A BOUNTY FOR KILLING POCKET GOPHERS WITHIN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the county commissioners of the county of Dodge, state of Minnesota, be and they hereby are empowered and authorized to pay a bounty for killing pocket gophers within said county, not to exceed fifteen (15) cents apiece, under such rules and regulations as said board of commissioners may adopt.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 298.

[S. F. No. 615.]

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF HASTINGS, MINNESOTA, TO EXPEND MONEY TO AID IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CHICAGO, BURLINGTON AND NORTHERN RAILROAD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the city of Hastings, county of Dakota, Minnesota, is hereby authorized to expend a sum of money, not exceeding five thousand (5,000) dollars, to aid in the construction of a spur track of the Chicago, Burlington and Northern Railroad from a point at or near the crossing of said railroad by the Chicago, Milwaukee and Saint Paul Railroad, near the bluff opposite the said city of Hastings, to a point on the north side of the Mississippi river immediately opposite the said city of Hastings.

SEC. 2. The city council of said city is hereby authorized and em-
