CHAPTER 331.

(H. F. No. 74.)

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY TREASURER OF MOWER COUNTY AND THE TREASURER OF FORMER VILLAGE OF LANSING TO PAY THE FUNDS OF SAID VILLAGE INTO THEIR HANDS INTO THE TREASURY OF LANSING TOWNSHIP.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the county treasurer of Mower county and the village treasurer of the former village of Lansing, in said county, be and they are hereby respectively authorized and directed to pay into the treasury of Lansing township all funds in the hands of either of said officers belonging to said former village of Lansing.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 332.

[H. F. No. 39.]

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OF RAMSEY COUNTY TO APPOINT ONE (1) OR MORE DEPUTIES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The register of deeds of Ramsey county, is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint one (1) or more deputy registers, which appointment or appointments shall be in writing, and said deputies shall each before entering upon the duties of his office, take
