CHAPTER 339.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINNE-APOLIS TO APPROPRIATE AND TRANSFER MONEYS FROM ITS GENERAL FUND TO THE THIRD WARD FUND TO REIMBURSE SAID THIRD WARD FOR MONEYS EXPENDED IN THE IMPROVEMENT OF CERTAIN ROADS THEREIN NAMED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The city council of the city of Minneapolis is hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate and transfer out of the general fund of said city to the third ward street fund the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000), to reimburse said ward for moneys heretofore laid out and expended in opening and improving the following roads leading from said ward to the country, to-wit: The Brooklyn, Osseo, Watertown, Corcoran, Medina and Shingle Creek, or the so called river road.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
