

CHAPTER 358.

[H. F. No. 1241.]

AN ACT GRANTING TO THE OWNER OF CERTAIN SWAMP LANDS IN TOWNSHIP THIRTY-THREE (33) AND THIRTY-FOUR (34) IN RANGE TWENTY-TWO (22) AND TOWNSHIP THIRTY-TWO (32) AND THIRTY-THREE (33) AND THIRTY-FOUR (34) IN RANGE TWENTY-THREE (23) IN ANOKA COUNTY AND TO SAID COUNTY, THE RIGHT TO LOWER THE LAKES IN SAID TOWNSHIPS FOR DRAINAGE PURPOSES.

WHEREAS there exists within the limits of townships thirty-three (33) and thirty-four (34) in range twenty-two (22), and townships thirty-two (32), thirty-three (33) and thirty-four (34) in range twenty-three (23) in Anoka county, large bodies of swamp lands amounting in the aggregate to over twenty-five thousand (25,000) acres which lands are damaged by reason of being overflowed. Therefore,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the owners of said lands or any one or more of them and also said county be and are hereby authorized and empowered in the drainage of said lands in townships thirty-three (33) and thirty-four (34) in range twenty-two (22) and townships thirty-two (32), thirty-three (33) and thirty-four (34) in range twenty-three (23), in Anoka county, to lower such of the lakes in said townships as may be necessary to drain the overflowed lands in said townships, *provided*, the consent of the owners of lands bordering on the lakes so to be lowered shall first be obtained.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 359.

[H. F. No. 1257.]

AN ACT TO MAKE THE VILLAGES OF MADISON AND DAWSON, IN LAC QUI PARLE COUNTY, SEPARATE ELECTION DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the village of Madison, in Lac qui Parle county, is hereby made an election district separate and distinct from the township of Madison in said county, for all purposes.

SEC. 2. That the village of Dawson, in said Lac qui Parle county, is hereby made an election district separate and distinct from the township of Riverside in said county, for all purposes.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
