## CHAPTER 365.

[H. F. No. 1801.]

AN ACT MAKING THE VILLAGE OF NEW RICHLAND A SEPARATE ELECTION DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the village of New Richland, in the county of Waseca, in said state, is hereby declared to be a separate election district for all purposes under the election laws of this state.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions

of this act are hereby repealed.

SEO. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 366.

[H. F. No. 1318.]

AN ACT TO ENFORCE AND CARRY INTO EFFECT THE JUDGMENTS OF THE JUSTICES OF THE PEACE OF THE TOWN OF MINNEAPOLIS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the dockets, files and papers of the justices of the peace in the town of Minneapolis, in the county of Hennepin, and state of Minnesota, be transferred and turned over to the justice of the peace for the district north and west of First (1st) avenue south, in the city of Minneapolis, said county and state; and said justice of the peace of said city of Minneapolis and his successors in office are hereby authorized and empowered to issue transcripts of judgments, executions and other writs and process necessary to enforce and carry into effect the judgments heretofore rendered by said justices of the peace in and for said town of Minneapolis, and said judgments shall stand on the same footing as judgments of said justice of the peace of said city of Minneapolis.

SEC. 2 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

the date of its passage.
