of the county at large, a sufficient fund for that purpose, to be known

as the county poor fund.

SEC. 9. The common council of any city, and the several towns and municipal corporations of incorporated villages shall le value to be levied each year, a tax upon the real and personal proin said cities, towns or villages, respectively, of such sum, not exceeding one (1) mill upon each dollar of assessed valuation, as it shall deem necessary to provide for the relief of poor persons having a legal settlement therein needing public relief or support; which tax may, if necessary, be in addition to and in excess of the aggregate amount of city or township taxation otherwise authorized by law to be levied therein.

SEC. 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the thirty-first (31st) day of May, eighteen hundred and eighty-nine

(1889).

CHAPTER 394.

[H. F. No. 40.]

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE OFFICIAL ACTS OF C. J. WILLIAMS AS DEPUTY REGISTER OF DEEDS OF RAMSEY COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That all and singular the official acts of C. J. Williams as deputy register of deeds of the county of Ramsey be and the same are hereby legalized and confirmed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

passage.

CHAPTER 395.

[H. F. No. 858.]

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE FEES AND COMPENSATION OF REGISTER OF DEEDS OF WINONA COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The fees and compensation of the register of deeds of Winona county shall be as follows:

For entering, indexing and recording any deed or other instrument, seven and and one-half $(7\frac{1}{2})$ cents for each folio, to be paid when the same is left for record.

For every certificate, ten (10) cents. For copies of any records or papers, when required, seven and one-half $(7\frac{1}{2})$ cents for each folio.

For recording any deed or any other paper in any other than the English language, fifteen (15) cents per folio.

For entering the discharge of mortgage in the margin of the record,

ten (10) cents.

For filing every instrument and making an entry thereof, when nec-

essary, five (5) cents.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after January first (1st), one thousand eight hundred and ninety 890).

CHAPTER 396.

[H. F. No. 657.]

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE SALARIES OF COUNTY OFFICERS IN WINONA COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The annual salary of the auditor in the county of Winona, shall be three thousand (3,000) dollars, including all clerk hire.

SEC. 2. The annual salary of the treasurer of the county of Winona, shall be two thousand five hundred (2,500) dollars, including all clerk hire.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts fixing different salaries or compensation or prescribing fees differing from the provisions of this act for the same service specified in this act are hereby repealed so far as the same may effect the county of Winona.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first (1st) day of January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-

one (1891).
