

CHAPTER 397.

[S. F. No. 657.]

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION OF PROBATE NOTICES
IN THE COUNTY OF STEARNS, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That all notices and publications provided for in the probate code of this state shall be printed and published in a newspaper printed and published in the English language in the county where the proceedings are had once in each week for three (3) successive weeks, *providing*, that whenever the judge of probate shall deem it for the best interest of all parties concerned, he may cause the same to be published in the English language in any paper in said county.

Provided further, that this act shall only apply to the county of Stearns.

SEC. 2. No general law hereafter passed shall be construed to modify or repeal the provisions of this act unless especially provided in said act.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 398.

[H. F. No. 663.]

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT NUDE BATHING IN ANY AND ALL LAKES IN
RAMSEY COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. Any person or persons who shall bathe or attempt to bathe in any nude condition in any lake within the limits of Ramsey county shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, before any court or justice of the peace having jurisdiction, shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten (10) dollars nor more than fifty (50) dollars for each offense, together with the costs of prosecution.

SEC. 2. Clothing covering the body from the waist to the knees shall be deemed sufficient covering against the provisions of this act.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
