CHAPTER 418.

[H. F. No. 878.]

AN ACT FIXING THE SALARY OF THE POLICEMEN OF THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The salary of each policeman of the city of Saint Paul shall hereafter be seventy-five (75) dollars per month, which salary shall be paid out of the city treasury of said city in the manner now provided by law.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts, whether general or special, inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 419.

AN ACT TO CONSTITUTE THE VILLAGE OF LUVERNE, ROCK COUNTY, MINNESOTA, A SEPARATE ELECTION DISTRICT, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANNER OF HOLDING OF ELECTIONS THEREIN, OTHER THAN FOR VILLAGE OFFICERS AND PURPOSES, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE COUNCIL THEREOF TO APPOINT JUDGES OF ELECTIONS OTHER THAN FOR VILLAGE OFFICERS AND PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The village of Luverne, Rock county, Minnesota, is hereby constituted a separate election district.

SEC. 2. All elections in said village, other than for village officers or purposes, shall be held and conducted in all things as if said village was a city of the said state containing less than four thousand
