AN ACT TO FIX THE SALARY OF THE PROBATE JUDGE OF THE COUNTY OF MILLE LACS.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND TWELVE (112) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF MINNESOTA FOR THE YEAR ONE THOU. SAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (1887), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS ONE (1) AND TWO (2) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN (113) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF MINNESOTA FOR THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885) RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF A PHONOGRAPHIC REPORTER FOR THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE COUNTY OF HENNEPIN."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter one hundred and twelve (112) of the special laws of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887) be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
