CHAPTER 429

[H. F. No. 938.]

AN ACT MAKING ALL MONEYS RECEIVED DURING FOUR (4) YEARS FROM LIQUOR LICENSES GRANTED IN ITASCA COUNTY A PART OF THE ROAD AND BRIDGE FUND OF SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION I. That hereafter all moneys received into the treasury of Aitkin county during the four (4) years next ensuing after the passage of this act from liquor licenses granted by the board of county commissioners of Itasca county be and the same are hereby made a part of the road and bridge fund of said Itasca county.

SEC. 2. Said moneys are to be expended for the construction and improvement of roads and bridges in said Itasca county under the

direction of the board of county commissioners of said county.

Sec. 3. This act to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 430.

(H. F. No. 934.]

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SALARY OF THE ASSESSOR OF RAM-SEY COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That for the faithful discharge of the duties of his office the assessor of Ramsey county shall receive per annum, payable in equal monthly installments out of the county treasury the amounts herein specified, namely: In odd numbered years ninety-five hundred (9.500) dollars per annum, and in even numbered years, eleven thousand five hundred (11,500) dollars per annum, which sums shall cover all clerk hire and assistants necessary in the performance of the duties of his said office.

SEC. 2. Any and all acts and parts of acts and all laws of this state whether special or general contravening or inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
