persons, or of which such person or persons have control, to run at large upon any highway or upon the lands of any other person or persons, in township one hundred and twenty-two (122) north, of range thirty-six (36) west, in the county of Kandiyohi, state of Minnesota, during the months of May, June, July, August, September and October in any year.

Sec. 2. Any person or persons who shall violate or neglect the provisions of section one (1) of this act, shall be liable for all damages that may be caused in consequence of the trespass of such ani-

mal or animals.

Sec. 3. The owner or occupant of any land or lands in said township may distrain all beasts doing damage thereon without regard to the sufficiency of the fences thereon; and when any such distress shall be made, the damages may be appraised and the beast or beasts disposed of and such action in the premises taken as is provided in the

general statutes for distraining beasts doing damage.

- SEC. 4. This act shall be submitted to the legal voters of said town for rejection or approval at the next annual town meeting after the passage of this act. Those voting in favor of this act shall have written or printed, or partly written and partly printed on their ballots the words, "To prevent the running at large of cattle, horses, mules or other domestic animals—Yes;" and those voting against said act shall have written or printed, or partly written and partly printed on their ballots the words, "To prevent the running at large of cattle, horses, mules or other domestic animals—No." Said vote shall be cast at said town meeting in the same manner as votes cast for town officers.
- SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 484.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND EIGHTY_ TWO (282) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUN-DRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885) ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF ANIMALS IN WASHINGTON COUNTY" SHALL APPLY TO THE TOWN OF MARINE IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The provisions of chapter two hundred and eighty-two (282) of the special laws for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), being an act entitled "an act to prohibit the running at large of animals in Washington county" shall apply to and

have full force and effect in the town of Marine in said Washington county and said act shall be enforced accordingly.

Sec. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby

repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
