have full force and effect in the town of Marine in said Washington county and said act shall be enforced accordingly.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 485.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THIRTEEN (13) OF CHAPTER TWO HUN-DRED AND EIGHTY-TWO (282) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF ANIMALS IN WASHINGTON COUNTY."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section thirteen (13) of chapter two hundred and eighty-two (282) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885) be and is hereby amended, by striking out the word "Mist" in the last line of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the word "Forest," and by inserting immediately after the word "Lake" in the last line of said section, the words "and Marine."

AN AGT TO PREVENT CATTLE AND OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS FROM RUNNING A'T LARGE IN THE TOWN OF CROW WING, IN THE COUNTY OF CROW WING.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to allow any cattle, horses, mules, asses, sheep or swine owned by them or of which they may have possessior or control, to run at large upon the public highways, or upon the lands of any other person during
