

CHAPTER 493.

[S. F. No. 277.]

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER ONE (1) IN LE SUEUR COUNTY AND TO ATTACH SUCH TERRITORY TO COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER FIFTY-SIX (56) IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following described lands to-wit: The east half of the northeast quarter ($e\frac{1}{2}$ of $ne\frac{1}{4}$) and the southeast quarter ($se\frac{1}{4}$) of section numbered thirty-one (31) in township number one hundred and twelve (112) north, of range number twenty-five (25) west, of the fifth (5th) principal meridian in the state of Minnesota and county of Le Sueur, be and the same is hereby detached from independent school district number one (1) in said county and attached and made a part of common school district number fifty-six (56) in said county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after February one (1), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889).

CHAPTER 494.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION SIX (6) OF AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT CREATING AN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE TOWN OF TAYLORS FALLS AND STATE OF MINNESOTA," APPROVED MARCH SIXTH (6TH), A. D. EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-ONE (1871).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section six (6) of chapter one hundred and three (103) of the special laws of the state of Minnesota approved March sixth, (6th), A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one (1871), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"It shall be the duty of said board of education, as soon as sufficient funds shall be realized therefor, to establish and maintain within the limits of said district, such number and grades of schools as said board shall deem for the best interests of said district. *Provided*, the number of grades shall not exceed four, to-wit:

"Primary department, intermediate department, grammar department and high school department, and to classify the pupils attending said schools in corresponding classes, with reference to the branches of study pursued and their proficiency therein, so that there shall be

taught in the primary department the rudiments of an English education; in the intermediate department such branches as are not provided for in the primary department, and prerequisite to respectable English education; in the grammar department such higher studies as the board may deem proper, and in the high school department all of the branches prescribed as prerequisite for admission to the collegiate department of the University of Minnesota.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 495.

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM THE VILLAGE OF JANESVILLE, IN WASECA COUNTY, IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND TO ATTACH THE SAME TO ADJOINING SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER TWENTY-NINE (29), IN SAID WASECA COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter, and the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section thirty-five (35); also that portion of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section thirty-four (34) lying and being south of the Winona and St. Peter railroad track, all in township one hundred and eight (108) north, range twenty-four (24) west, in said county of Waseca, state of Minnesota, and now being a part of the village of Janesville, in said county, be and the same is hereby detached from the said village of Janesville and attached to and made a part of the common school district number twenty-nine (29) in said Waseca county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
