

CHAPTER 57.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER FIFTY-EIGHT (58) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885), RELATING TO THE VILLAGE OF GLENCOE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2) of chapter fifty-eight (58) of the special laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words "except the south fifty (50) acres" in the fourth (4th) and fifth (5th) lines thereof and inserting in place thereof the words "and the north-west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section twenty-three (23)."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 58.

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION TWELVE (12) OF CHAPTER THREE (3) OF CHAPTER FOUR (4) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR (1874), RELATING TO INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE OF WILLMAR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section twelve (12) of chapter three (3) of chapter four (4) of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (1874), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows: "Section 12. All property, real and personal, in the village, except such as may be exempt by the laws of this state, or is village property, shall be subject to taxation not exceeding four (4) mills on the dollar per year for general purposes; such property shall also be liable for such special taxes as the village council are herein authorized to levy."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
