village when organized shall be known and designated as road district number one (1) of said town of Eidsvold, and such territory shall be a separate election district for all elections and shall be entitled to elect an assessor, who shall perform the duties required of assessors by the general laws of this state, within the corporate limits of said village.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 74.

[S. F. No. 524.]

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF ELK RIVER, THE SAME BEING CHAPTER TWELVE (12) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881) AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER SIXTY-EIGHT (68) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section fourteen (14) of chapter sixty-eight (68) of the special laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five (1885), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 14. That the common council of said village shall have the same power in laying out, changing and discontinuing streets and highways in said village as are possessed by township supervisors in the matter of laying out, changing and discontinuing town roads, and the same proceedings shall be had and taken by and before the common council of said village in laying out, changing and discontinuing streets, alleys and highways within said village, as are taken by and before town supervisors in laying out, changing and discontinuing town roads.

SEC. 2. That sections fifteen (15), sixteen (16), seventeen (17), eighteen (18), nineteen (19) and twenty (20) of said chapter sixtyeight (68), of special laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five (1885) be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
