

CHAPTER 75.

[S. F. No. 529.]

AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE CITY OF SAUK CENTRE," APPROVED MARCH FIFTH (5th), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE (1889).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section three (3) of chapter two (2) of an act entitled "an act to incorporate the city of Sauk Centre," approved March fifth (5th), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 3. At the first (1st) general election of city officers, in the year A. D., one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889), there shall be elected in each ward, two (2) aldermen, who shall each hold his office for the term of one (1) year, and one (1) alderman from each ward who shall each hold his office for the term of two (2) years, and thereafter there shall be elected at the annual city election in each even numbered year two (2) aldermen in each ward who shall each hold their office for two (2) years and until their successors are elected and qualified, and at the annual city election in each odd numbered year there shall be elected in each ward, one (1) alderman, who shall hold his office for the term of two (2) years and until his successor is elected and qualified. The city justices shall each hold their offices for the term of two (2) years and until their successors are elected and qualified.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
