AN ACT TO AMEND AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF OSSEO, HENNEPIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter nineteen (19) of the special laws for the year A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five (1875) be amended by adding after the word "beginning" in the ninth (9th) line of said section one (1) the following: "Also the west thirty-four (34) acres of the east half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of the northeast quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of section number thirteeen (13), township one hundred and nineteen (119), range twenty-two (22), which includes Maple Grove addition to the present village of Osseo.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 87.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER FIVE (5) OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF WINONA," APPROVED FEBRUARY TWENTY-FIRST (21st), A. D. ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (1887.)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That the act entitled "an act to amend the charter of the city of Winona", approved February twenty-first (21st), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, (1887) the same being chapter five (5) of the special laws of the state of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), be and the same is hereby amended by striking out from the tenth (10th) line of section one (1) of chapter seven (7) of said act the words "and sidewalks", where they occur in said line, and by inserting between the words "alleys" and "public" in the tenth (10th) line of said section and chapter the word "and", and by adding to and inserting in the third (3d) line of section two (2) of chapter seven (7) of the act aforesaid between the words "constructing" and "sidewalks" the words "reconstructing and repairing".

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

passage.
