

CHAPTER 116.

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY-NINE (259) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (1887), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO REGULATE THE SERVICE OF PROCESS OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF WASHINGTON COUNTY."

Chap. 259.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Chapter two hundred and fifty-nine (259) of the General Laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), entitled "An act to regulate the service of process of the district court of Washington county," is hereby repealed.

Requiring service of process in district court of Washington county to be made by sheriff or his deputies.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 117.

AN ACT REPEALING SECTIONS THREE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FOUR (324) AND THREE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE (325) OF CHAPTER FORTY-SIX (46) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE (1889).

Secs. 324 and 325
of (Probate
Code) Chap. 46.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Sections three hundred and twenty-four (324) and three hundred and twenty-five (325) of the Probate Code of Minnesota, being Chapter forty-six (46) of the General Laws of the state of Minnesota for one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889), be and the same is hereby repealed.

Abolishing fees of probate court.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
