## CHAPTER 164.

[S. F. No. 21.]

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE PRESENT SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Legislative expenses SECITON 1. That the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand (150,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general revenue fund, for the payment of the per diem, mileage and other expenses of the members and officers of the legislature during the present session.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 165.

[S. F. No. 870.]

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR ADDITIONAL LEG-ISLATIVE EXPENSES FOR THE CURRENT SESSION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Legislative oupenses. SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys of the state not otherwise appropriated, the sum of fifteen thousand (15,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to meet any additional expenses of the legislature of the state of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one (1891), not provided for by any appropriation heretofore made.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage.
