

CHAPTER 66.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION NINETY-SEVEN (97) OF CHAPTER ELEVEN (11) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO TAXES.

Amending Chap. 11, Sec. 97, Statutes of 1878, as amended by Chap. 16, General Laws of 1881.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section ninety-seven (97) of Chapter eleven (11) of the General Statutes of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878), as amended by section nineteen (19) of Chapter ten (10) of the General Laws for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one (1881), be and the same is hereby amended by inserting after the word "shall," in the first (1st) line of the second (2d) proviso of said section, the word "not," and by striking out the word "all," in the second (2d) line of said second (2d) proviso of said section, and inserting in lieu thereof the word "any."

Exempting lands sold for taxes previous to the amendment of 1881.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 67.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION FORTY-NINE (49) OF CHAPTER THIRTEEN (13) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), RELATING TO ROADS, CARTWAYS AND BRIDGES.

General Statutes 1878, amending Chap. 13, Sec. 49.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section forty-nine (49) of Chapter thirteen (13) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Sec. 49. *Roads in More than One Town—Petition to County Commissioners.*—If twenty-four (24) freeholders of any county containing one hundred (100) or more legal voters, and twelve (12) freeholders of any county containing less
