AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS TO REIMBURSE PERSONS WHO DEPOSITED MONEY TO BE APPLIED IN PAYMENT FOR LICENSES AND NOT SO APPLIED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the city of Minneapolis is hereby authorized and empowered to reimburse, for money deposited for license, the following named persons: Lizzie McGovern, in a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500); W. Cain, in a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500); Bernheimer Wine Company, in a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500); John Sigfried, in a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500); *Provided*, that nothing in this act shall be so construed as obligatory upon the city of Minneapolis to reimbursesaid persons, and that said persons, or either of them, shall only be reimbursed after due and satisfactory proof of their respective claim.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passsage

AN ACT TO AMEND "AN ACT TO AMEND AND CONSOLIDATE THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS," APPROVED MARCH EIGHT (5), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-ONE (1881), AS AMENDED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Chapter six (6) of the act entitled "An act to amend and consolidate the charter of the city of Minneapolis," approved March eight (3), one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one (1881), as amended by Chapter nine (9) of Special Laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven (1887), and as further amended by Chapter fifty-one (51) of Special Laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889), is hereby amended by striking out the whole thereof and substituting in place of the same the following, to-wit:
