

support and maintenance of the University of Minnesota, and shall be added to the general university fund and be payable to the order of the board of regents.

SEC. 2. From and after the expiration of the fiscal year ending July 31st, 1894, the annual appropriations for the support of the university made by chapter two hundred and forty-seven of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, and by the seventeenth item of section one of chapter two hundred and eighty-seven of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine, shall cease and determine; provided, that whenever the amount in the fund for the maintenance of the University of Minnesota raised under the provisions of this act shall be over the sum of one hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars in any one year, the amount over said sum shall be passed to the revenue fund of the state.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 111.

Church incorporation.

An act to amend section two of chapter eighty one of the general laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-seven, relating to the incorporation of parishes of the Protestant Episcopal church.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

Amending general laws of 1877, chap. 81.

Vestrymen in Protestant Episcopal churches.

SECTION 1. That section two of chapter eighty-one of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, entitled "An act to provide for the incorporation of parishes of the Protestant Episcopal Church," be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the word "eight" in said section and inserting in lieu thereof the word "nine."

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 112.

Minnesota soldiers' home.

An act to amend section twenty-eight of chapter one hundred and forty-eight of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, relating to the powers of the trustees of the "Minnesota Soldiers Home."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

Amending general laws of 1887, chap. 148.

SECTION 1. Section twenty-eight of chapter one hundred and forty-eight of the General Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven be and the same is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following proviso, to-wit:
