

such sidewalk to be constructed in all respects as is provided by the laws of such city, except that no petition therefor shall be necessary.

SEC. 2. All laws and parts of laws inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 215.

S. F. No. 574.

An act to authorize cities to sell any property owned and used by the city for market purposes.

City market houses.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That each and every city in this state be and is authorized and empowered by a resolution passed by a two-thirds vote of all members-elect of the city or common council of said city, and approved as is provided in the charter of said city, to sell and convey any real estate that is owned and has been used by said city for market purposes. Said sale and conveyance shall be made in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as may be authorized by the city or common council of such city.

Cities may sell market property.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 216.

H. F. No. 839.

An act to amend section 37 of chapter 19 of the general statutes of Minnesota of 1878, relating to distraining beasts doing damage.

Distraining beasts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section thirty-seven of chapter nineteen of the general statutes of Minnesota of 1878, relating to distraining beasts doing damage, be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words "and twenty-seventh" where they occur in the third line from the last in said section.

Damages for beasts at large in Seventh and Eighth wards, St Paul.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
