CHAPTER 12.

To amend Sec. 126 Chap. 11 G. S. 1878.

An act to amend section one hundred and twenty-six (126) of chapter eleven (11) of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, relating to county auditors furnishing towns with abstract of real estate assessments.

Be in enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one hundred and twentysix (126) of chapter eleven (11) of the general statutes of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

County auditor to furnish towns with abstract of real estate assessments. "Sec. 126. County auditor to furnish towns with abstract of real estate assessments. Each county auditor shall, on or before the first Tuesday of March, A. D., one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, and biennially thereafter, make out and transmit to the town clerk of each town in his county a certified copy or abstract of the real estate assessment roll of said town, as equalized by county and state boards of equalization."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 13.

To amend Sec. 86 Chap. 10 G.S. 1878.

An act to amend section eighty-six (86) of chapter ten (10) of the general statutes of Minnesota for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878), relating to the fees of town officers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section eighty-six (86) of chapter ten (10) of the general statutes of Minnesota for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Salaries of town officers.

"Sec. 86. The following town officers are entitled to compensation at the following rates for each day necessarily devoted by them to the service of the town in the duties of their respective offices: The town assessors shall receive for their services two dollars (\$2.00) per day while engaged in their respective duties as such assessors. The town clerks and supervisor shall receive for their services one dollar and fifty cents
